By applying for, accepting, and signing this permit, the applicant attests to the following: That he or she has read and understands the regulations promulgated by the Department of Public Safety with regard to trench safety. That he or she has read and understands the federal safety standards promulgated by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration on excavations: 29CFR 1926.650 et seq., entitled Subpart P "Excavations". 520 CMR: Department of Public Safety.

All Permits issued pursuant to 520 CMR 14.00 shall be posted in plain view on the site of the trench. All permits shall be made available to the permitting authority, any investigator from the Division of Occupational Safety, any inspector of the Department of Public Safety, or any other lawfully authorized authority.

Excavators engaging in any trenching operation who utilize hoisting or other mechanical equipment subject to M.G.L. c. 146 shall only employ individuals licensed to operate said equipment by the Department of Public Safety pursuant to M.G.L. c. 146 and the permit shall be presented to the licensed operator before excavation is commenced.

- *All regulated trenches must be either attended, covered, barricaded, backfilled.*
- *Excavators who use hoisting equipment must be licensed by Massachusetts Department of Public Safety.*
